Here's what we've done and will be doing for the foreseeable future;

- Clean and Sanitize touch surfaces
 - Pews in the sanctuary before and between each worship service
 - Doorknobs, Push Plates, Pull Openers, Etc.
 - Light Switches
- Serving coffee and water
- Opening doors for you
- Remove all items from the pews
- Continue using digital bulletins through the Church Center App

We want you to know that we will not be policing you when you come. If you are uncomfortable about attending, we understand. Feel free to wait until you are ready and utilize our online, livestream service (2nd service only). Our livestreaming services will be continuing indefinitely. We cannot control every variable and cannot guarantee perfect safety for everyone.

We will be having some guidelines that we would ask you all to follow. These will be revisited as time goes along.

In respect for others:

- No physical contact outside of family unit
 - No handshaking
 - No hugging
- Please maintain proper distancing
 - Approx. 6 feet apart
 - We will be seated in every other row of pews
- Feel free to bring and wear a mask (we will try to have some available for you but no guarantees on having masks for everyone)

Also note that there will not be nursery available, so if you need to remove your child you can bring them to the south side of the Fellowship Room (by the kitchen window) and please do your best to keep your children close to you at all times.
